

The Late Mr. Kanthasamy Krishnasarma

The Late Mr. Kanthasamy Krishnasarma was born in Thondaimanaru, Sri Lanka, on 1 January 1938. He was the eldest son of The Late Konamalai Kandasamy and The Late Poomany. He was the brother of Kanthimathy, Thirunavukarasu, Sambanthamoorthy and Rathisena (aka Ponmany).

He married Indra Devi Rasaiah of Malaysia in 1970.

He studied at Hartley College, worked briefly as a science teacher, and then worked as a Telecom Engineer. After his specialised training at British Telecom, he was a Chief Engineer at Telecoms. He also worked in the Customer Service. He left Sri Lanka in 1985 and went to Brunei Darussalam where he worked as a Telecom Engineer for six years. He migrated with his family to Sydney, Australia in 1992. After working for ten years in the Federal Court of Australia, he retired three years ago.

He passed away peacefully during his sleep on 25 December 2013 at his residence in North Strathfield.

He leaves behind his wife and three children: Keshan (married to Gayathiri), Indran, and Shanthini (married to Rathnathas) and four grandchildren: Ragavan, Mayavan, Shanghavi and Aditaya.
